Councilmember Woodruff moved, Councilmember Johnson seconded, to adjourn the Joint Public Hearing at 6:26 p.m.


Councilmembers Folloder, Johnson, Mathews, Rouse, and Woodruff voted “Aye”, “Noes” none.
