**In November 2016, we had the following criminal incidents in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:**

**Identity Theft**

On November 5, 2016, a resident on Hedwig Circle reported he received credit cards in the mail that he did not apply for.

On November 7, 2016, a resident on Woodsage reported that her personal information was used to open an account at Verizon.

On November 13, 2016, a resident on Dunbeath reported that his personal information was used to obtain a loan at PayPal.

Public Intoxication – 3  
Unlawful Carrying of a Weapon (pistol by documented gang member) – 1  
Unlawful Carrying of a Weapon (pistol by Felon) - 1
