ORDINANCE NO. 796

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HEDWIG VILLAGE, TEXAS; DECLARING THE UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE FOR COUNCIL POSITION NO. 4 ELECTED; PROVIDING THAT THE MAY 7, 2022, GENERAL MUNICIPAL OFFICERS ELECTION SHALL NOT BE HELD AS TO COUNCIL POSITION NO. 4; CONTAINING OTHER PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE SUBJECT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT OR IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEDWIG VILLAGE, TEXAS:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The City Council of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas (the "City"), passed and approved Ordinance No. 793 on January 11, 2022, for the purpose of electing three (3) officials of the City, to wit: Council Position No. 2, Council Position No. 3, and Council Position No. 4.
- <u>Section 2.</u> Pursuant to said Ordinance No. 793 and Section 143.007 of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the deadline for filing applications for a place on the ballot of the City's municipal officers election has expired and the deadline for filing as a write-in candidate has also expired.
- <u>Section 3.</u> The Assistant City Secretary, in accordance with Section 2.052, TEXAS ELECTION CODE, has certified to the City Council in writing that Matt Woodruff is unopposed for election to the office of Council Position No. 4.
- **Section 4.** In accordance with Section 2.053(a), TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the following unopposed candidates are hereby declared duly elected to the respective offices shown:

Council Position No. 4 – Matt Woodruff

- <u>Section 5.</u> Pursuant to Section 2.053(b), TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the election for Council Position No. 4 heretofore called and ordered by City of Hedwig Village, Texas, Ordinance No. 793 for the 7th day of May, 2022, shall not be held and is hereby cancelled.
- <u>Section 6.</u> Pursuant to Section 2.053(c) of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE, the ballot used at the general election held at the same time as an election for Council Position

No. 4, that would have been held, if the candidate for Council Position No. 4 was not declared elected, shall include the office and name of the candidate declared elected separately after contested races in the general election under the heading "Unopposed Candidates Declared Elected."

Section 7. In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.

<u>Section 8.</u> All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
