

## ORDINANCE NO. 844

### AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF HEDWIG VILLAGE, TEXAS, ON MAY 3, 2025; AND CONTAINING FINDINGS AND PROVISIONS RELATED TO THE SUBJECT.

**WHEREAS**, on January 9, 2025, the City Council of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas, (the "City") adopted Ordinance No. 842, which ordered that a General Election be held in the City on May 3, 2025, for the purpose of electing a Mayor and two (2) Council Members for two year terms; and

**WHEREAS**, said election was called and notices were given in accordance with the requirement of law, and the election was held in all material respects in conformity with the law; and

**WHEREAS**, the returns of such election have been duly and legally made and submitted to the City Council, and the City Council has examined such returns, including the tabulation attached hereto as Exhibit A and made a part hereof for all purposes;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HEDWIG VILLAGE THAT:**

**Section 1.** All of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are found to be true and are adopted as findings of fact by this City Council and as part of its judgment, particularly the tabulation of returns of the election set out in Exhibit A.

**Section 2.** The City Council now formally canvasses the returns of such election, and it is hereby adjudged, determined and declared that:

- (1) **Tom Jinks**, with a total of 381 votes cast for him, has been elected Mayor of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas for a two year term;
- (2) **Scott Davis**, with a total of 357 votes cast for him, has been elected Council Member Position No. 1 of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas for a two year term; and
- (3) **Miles Loveless**, with a total of 251 votes cast for him, has been elected Council Member Position No. 5 of the City of Hedwig Village, Texas for a two year term.

**Section 3.** The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to make the appropriate entries of information in the election register maintained by the City in accordance with provisions of Section 67.006 of the TEXAS ELECTION CODE.

**Section 4.** If any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or other part of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall ever be

held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this ordinance and the application of such word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, section or other part of this ordinance to any other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

**Section 5.** The City Council officially finds, determines and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hour, place and subject of each meeting at which this ordinance was discussed, considered or acted upon was given in the manner required by the Open Meetings Law, as amended, and that each such meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during such discussion, consideration and action. The City Council ratifies, approves and confirms such notices and the contents and posting thereof.
