**In May 2025, we had the following criminal incidents in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:**

**Assault of a Pregnant Woman & Sexual Assault**

- May 3, 2025 – 9075 Gaylord  
HVPD Officers responded to an assault call, where a Hispanic male suspect was accused of assaulting his pregnant wife and sexually assaulted her repeatedly. The male was arrested and charged with the two felony charges.

**Duty Upon Striking a Structure, Fixture, or Highway Landscaping**

- May 6, 2025 – Dunbeath Drive  
A construction worker backed into a large light pole with his truck. The damage is estimated at \$3500. The driver denied his actions and video positively identified the truck and driver. Charges are pending with further investigation.

**In the Commercial Districts, we had the following criminal incidents in May 2025:**

1 Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon – *while committing a BMV, a black male suspect was confronted by a witness and he brandished a pistol and threatened to shoot a witness. The suspect fled and the investigation is ongoing.*

1 Assault (Class A Misdemeanor)

7 Burglary of Motor Vehicles

1 Criminal Mischief

7 Thefts (5 – shopliftings)

**Arrests – May 2025**
