In June 2018, we had the following criminal incidents in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:

Burglary

On June 19, 2018, unknown suspect(s) entered an unlocked front door of an apartment at the Le Renaissance Apartments sometime between 4pm and 8pm and stole several items.

On June 21, 2018, unknown suspect(s) entered an unlocked back door of a residence on Denise Street sometime between 8:30pm and 9:50pm and stole cash and jewelry.

Credit Card Abuse

On June 7, 2018, a resident of the Le Renaissance apartments reported his credit card was used to make unauthorized purchases.

Fraud

On June 11, 2018, a resident on Hedwig Circle reported he received an email requesting he wire money to a colleague, which he did. He later learned the email was fraudulent.

On June 22, 2018, a resident of the Memorial Grove apartments reported he received an email requesting a copy of his driver's license. After sending the copy, he learned the email was fraudulent.

Terroristic Threat

On June 26, 2018, a guest at a residence on Brogden reported he received threatening text messages from a man who had been asked to leave the residence.
