**In March 2017, we had the following criminal incidents in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:**

**Assault**

On March 2, 2017, two males were involved in a physical altercation on Monte Cello.

**Burglary of a Motor Vehicle**

On March 14, 2017, a vehicle on South Lou Al was broken into and some tools were stolen.

On March 14, 2017, a fishing tackle box was stolen from an unlocked vehicle on Merridale.

On March 18, 2017, a vehicle in the Le Renaissance apartments was broken into and a gym bag containing a laptop and iPad was stolen.

On March 28, 2017, a vehicle in the Memorial Green apartments was broken into and some tools were stolen.

On March 28, 2017, a vehicle on Hedwig Circle was entered and cash and some shoes were stolen.
