**In March 2018, we had the following criminal incidents in the Residential District of Hedwig Village:**

**Criminal Mischief**

On March 20, 2018, a resident of the Memorial Grove Apartments noticed what appeared to be an area where someone had poked a hole in one of her windows.

On March 23, 2018, a resident on Blalock reported their mailbox was damaged, possibly by a construction vehicle.

**Theft**

On March 28, 2018, a resident of the Memorial Grove Apartments reported their license plates were stolen from their vehicle while parked in the parking lot of the apartments.

**Identity Theft**

On March 16, 2018, a resident on Echo Hollow reported their personal information was used to fraudulently file a tax return with the IRS.

**In the Commercial Districts, we had the following criminal incidents in March 2018:**

- 3 Burglary of Motor Vehicles
- 1 Credit Card Abuse
- 4 Criminal Mischief (damage to property)
- 7 Thefts (4 shopliftings, 3 other thefts)

**Arrests - March 2018**

The Hedwig Village Police Department arrested 50 persons in March for the following charges (note: some persons had more than one charge):

- Evading Arrest in a Motor Vehicle - 2
- Failure to Identify (Fugitive) - 1
- No Driver's License/Invalid Driver's License - 6
- Outstanding Warrants - 23
- Possession of a Controlled Substance (Xanax) - 1

Possession of a Controlled Substance (Methamphetamine) - 1  
Possession of Drug Paraphernalia – 4  
Possession of Marijuana – 1  
Public Intoxication – 1  
Theft – 1  
Unlawful Carrying of a Weapon (pistol) – 3
